2. INFORMATION IDENTIFYING THE QUALIFICATION

- 2.1 Name of qualification and title conferred: "**Diplôme du Programme Grande Ecole**" – a Master's degree in Management is awarded (Five years of higher education).
- 2.2 Main field(s) of study for the qualification: Business Management
- 2.3 Name and status of awarding institution: **KEDGE Business School** (an institution accredited by the French Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation and by the French "Conférence des Grandes Ecoles")
- 2.4 Name and status of institution administering studies: same as 2.3
- 2.5 Language(s) of instruction/examination: English and French

3. INFORMATION ON THE LEVEL OF THE QUALIFICATION

- 3.1 Level of qualification: **Masters degree** (Five years of higher education).
- 3.2 Official length of programme: The Programme Grande Ecole requires a minimum of **6 semesters** for students entering the pre-master year. A minimum of **4 semesters** is required for students entering the first year of Master.

Most of the students choose to enhance the Programme Grande Ecole with a **gap year** (two additional semesters) in order to carry out a professional or personal project.

3.3 Access requirements:

It is possible to be accepted into the "Programme Grande Ecole" in the pre-master year via an entry exam (ECRICOME), common to several Management Schools and reserved for students who have followed a two-year preparatory course ("Classes Préparatoires aux Grandes Ecoles" or CPGE). CPGE are undergraduate courses providing students with a strong grounding in science as well as classes in French literature and modern languages. They prepare students for the nationwide competitive entrance examinations for entry to the "Grandes Ecoles". 10% of the holders of a High School Diploma in Science (Baccalauréat) are judged to be admitted to the CPGE. The amount of work required is intensive, including lectures and personal work and earns students 120 ECTS credits.

It is also possible to enter the "Programme Grande Ecole" in the pre-master year via the "TREMPLEIN 1" entrance examination reserved for students having successfully completed 2 years of post-secondary education (DUT, BTS, etc.). These students are granted 120 ECTS credits.

Students can also integrate the "Programme Grande Ecole" in the 1st Master year via the "TREMPLEIN 2" entry examination, reserved for students having successfully completed 3 years of post-secondary education (Bachelor degree or higher). These students are granted 180 ECTS credits.

It is also possible to join the "Programme Grande Ecole" in the 1st Master year via an international entry examination, reserved for students holding an international Bachelor's degree.
